Day 1 | Siem Reap Arrival

Welcome to The Kingdom of Wonder!

Up on arrival Siem Reap International Airport, after immigration process and taking your luggage's, warm welcome by our professional tour guide and driver.

Day 2 | Explore Angkor

(B/L)



Today, start your tour to discover the world's worth heritage. Discover **Angkor Wat**, the largest religious monument in the world. Originally constructed as a Hindu temple dedicated to the god Vishnu for the Khmer Empire, it was gradually transformed into a Buddhist temple towards the end of the 12th century. It was built by the Khmer King Suryavarman I in the early 12th century in Yaśodharapura.

Afternoon, discover the Angkor Thom Complex (Great Angkor or Great City), was built by Angkor's greatest king, Jayavarman VII (1181 – 1219), including South Gate of Angkor Thom, the often first stop tour to Great City. Enter **Bayon Temple** (Giant smiling faces Temple), is a well-known and richly decorated Khmer temple at Angkor in Cambodia. Built in the late 12th or early 13th century as the official state temple of the Mahayana Buddhist King Jayavarman VII, the Bayon stands at the centre of Jayavarman's capital, **Angkor Thom**. Nearby, visit The Terrace of Elephant, part of the walled city of Angkor Thom, a ruined temple complex in Cambodia. The terrace was used by Angkor's king Jayavarman VII as a platform from which to view his victorious returning army. **The Terrace of Leper King**. It was built in the Bayon style under Jayavarman VII, though its modern name derives from a 15th-century sculpture discovered at the site. The statue depicts the Hindu god Yama, the god of death. Walk along the jungle to visit Taprohm temple-a temple in its 'natural state'. Surround by jungle, its labyrinth of stone hallways is overgrown with the roots and limbs of the massive Banyan trees which envelope the stones tentacles. This Taprohm temple is lately very famous for Tomb Raider Temple, where Angelina Jolie shoot the Hollywood Movie.

We stop at Pre Rup Temple, wait to view the impressive sunset on this mountain temple.

Day 3 | Banteay Srei – Grand Circuit

(B/L)

At morning, we'll traveling through the countryside view with green & yellow sceneries depending on season by passing many villages, schools, pagoda, paddy rice fields, palm tree, Mango & Cashew farm etc... We stop to visit **Prasat Banteay Srei**, a well carved and well-preserved Banteay Srei. The detailed reliefs on this smaller sandstone structure are regarded as the finest, most skillfully crafted in Cambodia. Banteay Srei has only been accessible since the late 1990s, when the Khmer Rouge left the area.

On the way back visit **Banteay Samre**. Continue to visit **Grand Circuit**; Preah Khan temple. Built by King Jayavarman VII, Preah Khan is, like Ta Prohm, a place of towered enclosures and shoulder-hugging corridors. However, it is in a good state of preservation, and ongoing restoration efforts should maintain and even improve this situation. Keep going to the next stop; we will meet at the fountain Neak Pean, which is built in the middle of a pool, represents the paradisiacal Himalayan Mountain Lake, and is

guarded by stone figures of harnessed elephants (so-called Ta Som and Eastern Mebon). Drop off at hotel.

Day 4 | Koh Keh – Beng Mealea (B/D)

At morning, we set off to Koh Ker (around 2.30hrs drive). **Koh Ker**, it was once an ancient capital of Cambodia that built by King Jayavaraman IV (AD 928-942) with 35 meters high and its design resembles a seven-stepped stupa, The temple faces west toward Angkor city. It was built to worship Trempuvasvara, the god of happiness. Continue another drive 1hrs to **Beng Mealea**, then walk within the lush jungle to explore the lost temple "Beng Mealea". Since the temple was constructed during the reign of king Suryavarman II in the early 12th century until then it's never been restored again. It provides wonderful adventure which you're going to climb over/down the ruined rocks, walking into the gallery to unlock the carvings and its interesting history of the Hindu temple related Angkor time.

Back to hotel and waiting time doing to have dinner at outside.

Overnight at hotel

Day 5 | Kulen Mountain (Thousand Lingas) (B/D)

After breakfast, we leave hotel and drive 58kms from Siem Reap town to the north of province to visit the sacred hilltop, the home of God. Mahendraparvata is considered a holy mountain in Cambodia, of special religious significance to Hindus and Buddhists who come to the mountain in pilgrimage. It also has a major symbolic importance for Cambodians as the birthplace of the ancient Khmer Empire, for it was at Phnom Kulen that King Jayavarma II proclaimed independence from Java in 804 CE. The Kulen National Park contains many sites of natural and historical interest. A magnificent waterfall dominates the forest terrain and draws countless local visitors on weekends and national holidays. Visit The River of a Thousands Lingas- The cult of worshipping carved in the riverbed which represent to Hindu God of Shiva. Walk via along flight of steps to visit Biggest Reclining Buddha Statue housed on a massive boulder which is believed as The Holiest in the Country. A viewing platform at the top affords sweeping views of the surrounding jungle and hillsides. You enjoy the picnic local food on mountain. Then Enjoy and then take the nice photos of Nicest Waterfall in Cambodia.

Late Afternoon will return to Siem Reap town and a short visit one local village names Banteay Srey Village to see inhabitants make natural palm sugar and other daily usage products.

Overnight at hotel

Day 6 | Siem Reap – Departure (B)

Breakfast at the Hotel.
